# SEXUAL & REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

## A Sexual Health & Family Planning Australia Certificate Course for Medical Practitioners

### The Course

This is an intensive course covering important specialist information on Sexual and Reproductive Health. The course is accredited nationally by SH & FPA (Sexual Health & Family Planning Australia). It is also accredited by the RACGP and ACRRM.

### Course Content

- Sexual history taking
- Contraception – all methods with optional Implanon training
- Medical aspects of Termination of Pregnancy
- STIs – diagnosis and management – bacterial and viral STIs including BBV and HIV, HPV and Pap smears
- Common gynaecology including issues for adolescents and sub-fertility, menopause
- Adolescent health
- Vulval health
- Sexual and relationship counselling
- Sexuality
- Aspects of sexual dysfunction

The course has two components:

**1. Theory** – five days (Monday to Friday), classroom-based, followed by exams on Saturday.

**2. Practicum** - seven practical sessions.

It is possible to undertake the theory component with Family Planning Victoria (FPV) and the Practicum in another State. In this case, please pay the Theory fee to FPV and contact the Family Planning Organisation in your selected state to arrange your Practicum. Please note that other States' fees and arrangements may vary from those of FPV.

### Entitlements

The SH & FPA Certificate in Sexual & Reproductive Health is awarded after a course participant has successfully completed both the theory and the practicum.

A FPV Certificate of Attendance is provided to a course participant who chooses to complete the five day theory course only

### 2007 Dates:

August 6<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup>, Monday-Friday

### Pre-requisites

Each participant must have an MBBS or equivalent.

In order to undertake the practical component, you must possess current medical registration in Victoria and medical indemnity.

Please also note that you must have current registration in the State where you wish to undertake your Practicum.

### Examination

- **MCQ exam:** 50 questions, 75 minutes to complete.
- **OSCE exam:** 8 questions comprising 4 written, short answer questions and 4 consultations where the participant acts as the doctor in a mock consultation.

### Practicum

Seven sessions (3.5 hours each) of practical clinical work. During the first session, the participant observes the consultation. During the following six sessions, the participant conducts the consultations and the FPV doctor observes. The participant may book practical sessions at either FPV's Box Hill clinic or the Action Centre, FPV's youth-focused clinic in Elizabeth Street, Melbourne.

### RACGP Points

The course is split into modules and points are attached to each module.

**Module 1** - First 3 days of course = 30 Category 1 points

**Module 2** - Last 2 days of course plus exam on 6<sup>th</sup> day = 30 Category 1 points **OR Module 2A** - Last 2 days of course plus pre-course and post-test assessment and evaluation documents = 30 Category 1 points

**Module 3** - seven clinical sessions with S & RH doctors = 30 Category 1 points.

To obtain the SH & FPA Certificate in S & RH, Modules 1, 2 and 3 need to be completed. (ie not 2A-this is for those not wanting the full certificate but wish to get 60 points for the week's course)

### ACRRM Points

ACRRM PDP = 105 (55)

MOPS O&G/Women's Health = 105

### Course Fee

### Fees include

- All costs associated with the delivery of the SH & FPA Certificate in Sexual and Reproductive Health
- The SH & FPA Certificate in Sexual & Reproductive Health (plus postage) if completing both components
- The FPV Certificate of Attendance, if undertaking just the five days of the Theory component
- One CD Rom copy of 'Contraception; an Australian Clinical Practice Handbook'
- 12 months FPV library membership.
- CD Rom: reference articles & pre-reading

Course registration requires full payment of the course fee unless other arrangements have been made with the Manager, Education and Training Services.

**Cancellation** – FPV will charge a cancellation fee of 10% of the course fee for cancellations made within 10 working days of course commencement.

### Other Options for FPV Medical Education

- Attendance at specific course presentations may be possible for doctors not wishing to attend the full theory course. The course timetable is available four weeks before the course begins. A daily fee applies.
- Supervised Clinical Attachments (RACGP points apply) may be arranged for a fee. Please contact (03) 9257 0133 to inquire about observation sessions with an FPV doctor conducting consultations with clients on Sexual and Reproductive Health issues.
