Content

- Sexual history taking
- Contraception (including all methods with optional Implanon training)
- Medical aspects of termination of pregnancy
- STI diagnosis and management of bacterial and viral STIs (including syphilis, HSV, HPV and HIV)
- Pap smears
- Common gynaecology (including issues for adolescents, sub-fertility and menopause)
- Adolescent health
- Male sexual health
- Vulval health
- Sexual and relationship counselling
- Social impacts on sexual health
- Lesbian and bisexual women's health
- Aspects of sexual dysfunction
- Adult sexual assault

Course components:

1. Theory: five days (Monday to Friday), classroom-based.
2. Exam: Friday 3.30 – 6.30pm.
 - Written multiple choice questions and short answers: 75 minutes to complete.

- OSCE exam: comprising four clinical doctor / patient scenarios.
- 3. Practicum: Seven practical sessions (3.5 hours each).
 - During the first session, the participant observes the consultation.
 - In the following six sessions, where appropriate, the participant conducts the consultation and the FPV doctor observes.

Please note: You may book practical sessions at either FPV's Box Hill or Action Centre clinics.

It is possible to undertake the practicum in another state. In this case, please pay the theory fee to FPV and contact the family planning organisation in your selected state to arrange your practicum.

Please note: fees and arrangements of other family planning organisations may vary from those of FPV.

Entitlements

The SH&FPA Certificate in Sexual & Reproductive Health is awarded to participants who successfully complete the theory, exam and practicum.

Participants who choose to only complete the five day theory course receive an FPV Certificate of Attendance.

Pre-requisites

Each participant must hold an MBBS or equivalent.

To undertake the practical component, you must have current medical registration in Victoria (or the state in which you wish to undertake your practicum) and current medical indemnity insurance.

RACGP Points

Theory (days) 1-5: 40 Category 1 points

Clinical sessions: 40 Category 1 points

Fees

Theoretical, exam and clinical:

\$1570.00 + \$157.00 GST = \$1727.00

Theoretical only:

\$920.00 + \$92.00 GST = \$1012.00

One day option/s:

\$200 per day (including GST)

Fees include:

The 2010 certificate course program has been designed to allow doctors not wishing to attend the full theory course to attend specific theme days. Please view the course timetable at www.fpv.org.au. This is an excellent opportunity for GPs wanting a refresher in specific areas of sexual and reproductive health.

Clinical attachments

Supervised Clinical Attachments (RACGP points apply) and IUD insertion training may also be arranged for a fee. Clinical attachments are available at both our Box Hill and Action Centre clinics.
