

CLINIC FEES AT FAMILY PLANNING VICTORIA

Under 23 and concession card holders

People aged 22 and under and anyone who holds a valid concession card will be bulk billed for most general consultations.

Medicare claims are submitted directly to Medicare and rebates sent by Medicare to your registered account usually within 48 hrs. Pharmacy costs may apply (payable directly to the pharmacy) if a prescription is issued as part of your care. We recognise that some clients might be experiencing financial hardship. In these circumstances, we encourage you to discuss your situation with a clinician at your appointment.

If you do not have a current Medicare Card

You will be charged the full fees with no rebate. Pathology fees will also apply for any tests ordered. We do not process private health insurance claims, but we can provide a receipt to submit to your insurer. Fees are a guide only and your total costs and out of pocket expenses may vary on the day. All our fees are subject to review from time to time.
